The City received three requests for records from you on December 9, 2014. With your consent the City was granted extended time to respond to the requests. Thank you for your cooperation in the extension of time.

The first of the three requests was for:

- All e-mail, memos, correspondence, presentations or reports generated by the mayor and City Council members that make reference to Mulligans Golf and Games (otherwise referred to as “Mulligans” or “Mulligan’s”)
- This would include correspondence with all city employees, senior staff, mayor, council and any outside persons including other governmental agencies, contractors and citizens. (This request covers the time period October 24, 2014 – December 9, 2014).
- If any of this type of communication occurred on personal devices, addresses, or social media including Facebook or Twitter it is also requested should be disclosed, particularly from e-mail addresses: Seethaler@ldschurch.org, mark4sjc@gmail.com, dralvord@gmail.com.
- All digital files including scans if any may be provided on CD or DVD; paper correspondence if any may be provided via regular black and white photocopy.

In response the City identified 264 emails, 251 which are public and responsive. The remaining 13 emails are either not records or are records classified as protected or private due to privilege, draft status or due to personal information. There were no texts provided for this time period. The City was not provided any memos, correspondence, presentations, or reports that were not included in the emails or that are not already posted in public on the City website as part of the “Mulligans History Research Book” on

the front page or part of the minutes in which the record was presented. The minutes of each meeting are available on the City's website under the City Recorder.

- All digital files including scans if any may be provided on CD or DVD; paper correspondence if any may be provided via regular black and white photocopy.

In response the City identified 222 emails, 207 which are public and responsive. The remaining 15 emails are either not records or are records classified as protected or private due to privilege, draft status or due to personal information. There were no texts provided for this time period. The City was not provided any memos, correspondence, presentations, or reports that were not included in the emails or that are not already posted in public on the City website as part of the "Mulligans History Research Book" on the front page or part of the minutes in which the record was presented. - All digital files including scans if any may be provided on CD or DVD; paper correspondence if any may be provided via regular black and white photocopy.

In response the City identified 276 emails, 235 which are public and responsive. The remaining 36 emails are either not records or are records classified as protected or private due to privilege, draft status or due to personal information. There were no texts provided for this time period. The City was not provided any memos, correspondence, presentations, or reports that were not included in the emails or that are not already posted in public on the City website as part of the "Mulligans History Research Book" on

the front page or part of the minutes in which the record was presented. The minutes of each meeting are available on the City's website under the City Recorder.

You have the right to appeal any part of the response to your request to the chief administrative officer of the City. A notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days from the date of this letter. Your notice of appeal must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and explanation of what relief you are seeking.
