

## Qualifications

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to Bid#1206-004 : Pre-employment and Annual Health Examinations and Other Related Services.

The University of Utah Health Care South Jordan Health Center is able to provide a complete continuum of health care services to the employees of the City of South Jordan. There currently exists a well-established and fully-integrated system of care to respond to and manage the needs of the injured worker, as well as occupational medicine services that are designed to protect and promote the health and safety of the police officers and firefighters working for the city.

The South Jordan Health Center opened in January 2012 and is located in the Daybreak area of South Jordan. However, the Occupational Medicine Program has been in operation at our University Redwood Center location with the same group of providers for over 9 years. We have been performing firefighter and police examination services for several area municipalities for the past three years. The South Jordan Occupational Medicine Clinic is a second location for our providers and staff. This second location has enhanced our ability to meet the needs of workers in the southwest part of the valley.

All services needed for exams are located within our clinic (laboratory, x-ray, radiology, spirometry and audiometry screening). This allows for timely completion of exams.

Treatment of work-related injuries and illness is also streamlined by having a full array of diagnostic and treatment services under one roof, including an on-site pharmacy and ready access to a variety of specialists if needed.

The Occupational Medicine Clinic at the South Jordan Health Center is staffed by occupational medicine physicians, a case management team, and a highly- trained patient care team designed to efficiently meet the needs of the employee.

University of Utah Occupational Medicine specialists are nationally recognized as leaders in the field, and offer the highest level of training and expertise in the intermountain region. The depth and breadth of clinical experience from this team of providers ensures the best of evidence-based care.

The philosophy of the University Occupational Medicine Program places great emphasis on early return to work following a work-related injury or illness. We recognize that there are many levels of financial consideration involved in managing the costs of an occupational injury, and we place our greatest emphasis on helping the employer to manage the cost of lost time wage replacement as well as helping to manage employee morale during the recovery period.

Our comprehensive case management program offers early intervention, frequent monitoring, and facilitation of communication among all interested parties. A team approach, which actively invites and involves the adjusters and employee's supervisor, ensures that injured workers are back to work in a timely manner with minimal lost time wherever possible.

The South Jordan Health Center is part of the larger University of Utah Health Care system and meets all local, state and federal the requirements for providing health care services, including the types of insurance coverages noted in section 2.14 of the bid.
