RE: Fatal auto versus motorcycle crash

****Please review the following information for consideration to be included in routine reporting.****

At 8:59 a.m., South Jordan Police and Medical responded on the report of an auto versus motorcycle crash at 10478 South Redwood Road. An off-duty paramedic arrived on scene right after the crash and found the rider of the motorcycle deceased.

A blue Hyundai Elantra driven by a 43-year old South Jordan resident was exiting the shopping center west onto Redwood Road and pulled out into the path of the southbound motorcycle. The driver of the Hyundai Elantra did sustain non-life threatening injuries and was transported to Intermountain Medical Center by ambulance. Her condition is being listed as fair.

The rider of the motorcycle is being identified as Artem Milne age 21 of Murray, Utah. Mr. Milne was wearing a helmet; however, do the severity of the crash it did not afford him the necessary protection to save his life.

This case is still under investigation to determine other factors that may have contributed to this incident.

“This is an unfortunate reminder to all motorists that with warmer weather we all need to be conscious of motorcycles, bicyclists and pedestrians using the roadways. These other modes of transportation may be harder to see and motorists should stop for an extended time to ensure the roadway is clear before proceeding,” Master Officer Samuel Winkler of the South Jordan Police Department.
