****Please review the following information for consideration to be included in routine reporting.****

Shortly after 8:00 A.M. on Sunday, May 31, 2015, officers with the South Jordan Police Department responded to 4353 West Lennox Drive (9433 South) on the report of a single vehicle having collided with a tree.

Officer arrived and during the investigation determined the driver of the vehicle, 36-year old Robin Lance of South Jordan, had been driving intoxicated while delivering newspapers. Mrs. Lance also had her four young children in the car with her (ages 4, 5, 9 and 11). None of the occupants were wearing seatbelts and suffered minor injuries that did not require medical attention.

Mrs. Lance had been driving east on Lennox Drive and passed out while driving. The vehicle then drifted off of the road to the left striking several trees. The vehicle continued east and stopped against a phone junction box.

Mrs. Lance was determined to have an alcohol content of 0.30 (two and a half times the legal limit).

Mrs. Lance was transported to the Salt Lake County Adult Detention Center on charges related to driving under the influence with children in the vehicle, failure to maintain safe lane travel and no proof of insurance. Mrs. Lance was issued a warning for her seatbelt violation and for the children not being restrained.
