**\*\*Please review the following information for consideration to be included in routine reporting.\*\***

The South Jordan Police Department responded to the report of bank robbery at 11:22 am on Tuesday, November 25, 2014, at the Zion's Bank at 4753 W Daybreak Pkwy in South Jordan.

Two males entered the store and demanded money from the clerks. The clerks complied and the suspects left with an undisclosed amount of money. The suspects did not show or threaten the use of weapons.

The males are being described as:

Suspect #1 – White male, 5'08"-5'10", medium build wearing black pants, black hoodie with "NYC" on it and a black mask with eye holes cut out.

Suspect #2 – White male, 5'08"-5'10", medium build wearing black pants, black hoodie with a small unknown logo/writing on it and a black mask with eye holes cut out.

The suspects were seen running to a brown colored 4-door passenger car (possible Toyota) with a white paper covering the license plate. The vehicle fled east and north into the East Lake area of Daybreak.

Anyone with information on this bank robbery is urged to call the South Jordan Police Department at 801-840-4000. You can remain anonymous. "The South Jordan Police Department would like to hear from anyone who may have seen a similarly described vehicle driving recklessly from the scene or noticed a vehicle with paper covering the license plate in the area. A small piece of information from the public could be the crucial piece needed to solve this case. We urge anyone with information to call us with that information," Master Officer Samuel Winkler, South Jordan Police Department.
