SOUTH JORDAN, UT– The City of South Jordan will host a Radon Awareness open house on January 21 from 6-7 p.m., at South Jordan City Hall.

January is National Radon Awareness Month-the city is providing information to residents about radon gas, how to test for radon and how to mitigate if their home tests high for radon.

Residents can speak to certified experts; learn how to test and mitigate radon and attend a free 10-minute radon information classes. The City will give out free radon test kits to the first 50 city residents, proof of residency required.
