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## **First-of-Its-Kind Transit Oriented Development Breaking Ground for SoJo Station**

**SOUTH JORDAN, UT** —South Jordan City, along with Inmoment, Utah Transit Authority, Millrock Development, and Stack Real Estate will break ground on a first of its kind transit oriented development, SoJo Station on May 24, 2016.

Located next to South Jordan FrontRunner Station, the development will include two, six-story 180,000 square foot Class A office towers, a two-level parking structure, and LEED® Silver Designation (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) buildings. An Embassy Suites hotel is expected to be developed as a part of the project in July 2016.

“This area is the gateway to our city and this project offers tremendous potential for economic development,” said South Jordan City Manager Gary Whatcott.

SoJo Station will offer two six-story high-rise addresses with high profile I-15 visibility and immediate access off 10600 South. Inmoment, a global customer experience management technology firm currently based in Murray, will be the anchor tenant in the first of the two buildings.

“The investment in this transit oriented development goes beyond just the immediate site, but to encourage more growth in the area all around it,” said South Jordan City Economic Development Director Brian Preece. The project will have a 160-room Embassy Suites hotel also in the future and pads for retail, fitness facility, conference center and restaurants.
