### **South Jordan City Police Department Responds to Suicidal Subject**

SOUTH JORDAN, UT – On March 16, 2016, at approximately 2:00 p.m. the South Jordan Police Department responded on a report of 57 year old male that was making vague threats of suicide and was reportedly armed with a handgun in his home in the area of 11600 S. Keystone Dr.

When officers arrived on scene they verified no one else was in the home with the individual and no one else had been threatened. Officers setup containment in the area and attempted to contact the individual numerous times in order to verify his welfare, he responded and asked to be left alone. Around 6:00 p.m. officers on scene could see the individual sleeping inside his R.V. on the property and he appeared to be okay. Officers decided to leave the area and let the individual sleep rather than forcing the issue and taking the chance of someone getting hurt. A message was left asking the individual to contact the police to let us know he is okay or if he would like any help.

There is no reason to believe the individual is a threat to the public.
