UPDATE: Identity of persons involve in double-fatal crash.

SOUTH JORDAN, UT – November 4, 2014

The drivers who passed away from injuries sustained following a car accident at the intersection of Daybreak Parkway and Mountain View Highway in South Jordan City are being identified as Michael Teahon, a 46-year-old male from Sandy, and Robynn Denamur, a 23-year-old female from Herriman. Both victims were initially air lifted to area hospitals in extremely critical condition and later succumb to their injuries.

The accident took place at approximately 12:00 p.m. on Monday. Initial reports from witnesses suggest that the westbound 2003 Mitsubishi Galant driven by Mrs. Denamur did not stop for the red signal and was struck by the southbound 2011 International box truck operated by Mr. Teahon.

The case is still an active investigation and no additional information is available at this time.
