Waterline Break at 6220 West 10200 South

South Jordan, Utah—July 22, 2016—A main water line at 6220 West and 10200 South (Old Bingham Highway) was damaged by crews working in the area this afternoon. The line is anticipated to be down for up to 24 hours. Several meter stations in South Jordan and West Jordan have been affected and residents may experience low water pressure or no water availability while the water line is down.

To ensure enough indoor water supply for residents and adequate fire suppression if necessary, residents and businesses located west of 4000 West are asked to not water lawns, gardens or use water for any other outdoor use during the next 24 hours. This will require residents to adjust or turn off their sprinkler irrigation controllers.

Due to the break, there is restricted access on Old Bingham Highway between 6400 and 6200 West. Crews from Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District (JVWCD) are currently assessing the damage and will offer updates as they are available.
