### South Jordan Utility Budget Billing Sign Up!

Beginning in October, South Jordan residents may begin enrollment for budget billing. If you are currently enrolled in budget billing, you will not need to re-enroll. Your new budget billing amount will appear on the November billing. Budget billing allows customers to pay the same monthly payment regardless of actual charges. Each November, the monthly payment amount will be adjusted to account for actual water usage. In order to qualify for budget billing, a customer must reside at the budget billing address for twelve months. Budget billing may be canceled at any time. Open enrollment occurs during October of each year, with the plan year beginning in November.
