Rules:

1. In order to comply with local health regulations, the following is required of all entrants. No ingredient may be pre-cooked in any way prior to the commencement of the official cook-off. The only exceptions are canned tomatoes, tomato sauce, peppers, pepper sauce, beverages, broth and grinding and/or mixing of spices. Meat may be treated, pre-cut or ground. MEAT MAY NOT BE PRE-COOKED. All other ingredients must be chopped or prepared during the preparation period. (8:00am – 9:00am)
2. You are responsible for providing all of your own ingredients and spices necessary to make at least one large pot of chili. You must be prepared to make at *least* 32 quarts of chili, reserving at least 1.5 quarts for the judges. As the popularity of this event grows, so does the number of tasters, so prepare wisely.
3. You are responsible for bringing your cooking heat source. We would prefer that these be “camping style” stoves. No open flames or fire pits will be allowed or provided. You may use a Dutch oven as long as it can rest and is heated on your camping stove. The City will provide tables, water for cooking and cleanup, small cups for samples, and other items.
4. While we realize that many people enjoy very spicy or very hot foods, some people may not. If your chili is spicy and/or hot, please advise any residents before providing a sample to them. Additionally, many people may have certain food allergies. If there is something in your chili that is known to be a common allergen, but it is not readily identifiable in your chili, please advise any resident that it may contain certain allergens. For example, if your chili contained a dairy product, you are required to place a small sign that says “This chili contains dairy”. This is done to help insure the health and safety of all our guests.
5. The judgments of the chili cook off staff, in regards to rules and decisions regarding prizes, are final.
6. The City of South Jordan is the sponsor of this event, and all of the City’s decisions regarding rules and entrants are final.
7. Please arrive at City Hall by 8:00 a.m. on Sept. 24th for set up. A meeting, for all entrants, is required at 8:30 am. You may begin cooking at 9:00 am. Judging will begin at noon. You should be ready for public tasting at this time.
8. You are required to clean up immediately at the conclusion of the event. If everyone helps clean up their areas, this will go very smoothly.

We look forward to this Chili Cook-Off to be the best ever.
