South Jordan Police Department Makes Arrest in Stabbing

SOUTH JORDAN, UT – The South Jordan Police Department has made an arrest in this morning's stabbing, which resulted in three people going to the hospital including the suspect (Andrew Russell – 27 year old male).

Just prior to midnight on May 25, 2020, we received a call from the U of U Health Center in South Jordan that two males, one 41-year-old male and one 23-year-old male, were brought in with stab wounds. The 41-year-old male was flown to U of U Medical Center in Salt Lake City with life threatening injuries, as of this release he is in critical but stable condition. The 23-year-old male was transported to Intermountain Medical Center with non-life threatening injuries and is currently in stable condition. The suspect was also stabbed in the altercation and showed up at Jordan Valley Medical Center with non-life threatening injuries. Upon his release, he was transported to the Salt Lake County Adult Detention Center where he was booked on suspicion of two counts of aggravated assault (2nd degree felony) and possession of a weapon by a restricted person (3rd degree felony).

At this time we believe the altercation resulted from a disagreement between the three men over them helping their friends move out of the residence at 5807 W. Hill Stone Dr., South Jordan UT. There was an altercation earlier in the evening between the suspect and the 23-year-old victim and then another altercation just before the stabbing between the suspect and the 41-year-old victim.
