South Jordan Police Department Safely Takes Barricaded Suspect into Custody

SOUTH JORDAN, UT – The South Jordan Police Department has safely taken the suspect, 38-year-old Ruben Chacon, in today’s SWAT standoff into custody.

This morning, June 13, 2020, just after 10:30 a.m. we received a report from a victim of domestic violence. The victim reported her boyfriend, Ruben Chacon, showed up at her residence last night and assaulted her, held her captive and broke cell phone when she tried to call for help. Officers responded to the residence in the area of 10400 S. 2950 W. and attempted to make contact with Ruben when he refused to come out of the home or answer negotiators calls. The South Valley SWAT Team was called out, and after several hours Ruben was found in the attic of the home and safely taken into custody.

Ruben was transported to the Salt Lake County Adult Detention Center where he was booked on suspicion of two counts of domestic aggravated assault (2nd degree felony), two counts of domestic assault (misdemeanor B), unlawful detention (misdemeanor B), domestic criminal mischief (misdemeanor B), and interruption of a communication device (misdemeanor B).
