

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF CERTIFICATION OF ANNEXATION PETITION

The City of South Jordan (the “**City**”) provides this Notice of Receipt of Certification of Annexation Petition (this “**Notice**”) as required by and in accordance with Utah Code Annotated Section 10-2-406, as amended and now in effect.

The City hereby provides notice that:

1. Kennecott Utah Copper LLC and Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District filed that certain Annexation Petition with South Jordan City, Salt Lake County, Utah, on December 22, 2022 (the “**Petition**”).
2. On January 3, 2023 (the “**Certification Date**”), the Recorder certified the Petition pursuant to Utah Code Annotated Section 10-2-405(2)(c)(i), as amended and now in effect (the “**Certification**”).
3. The South Jordan City Council (the “**Council**”) received and accepted the Petition on the Certification Date and received notice of the Certification on the Certification Date.
4. The Petition proposes that South Jordan City annex an area located in unincorporated Salt Lake County at approximately Bacchus Highway and 11800 South and more particularly described and depicted on the map included herein (the “**Annexation Area**”).
5. The Petition is available for inspection and copying at the office of the South Jordan City Recorder (the “**City Recorder**”).
6. THE COUNCIL MAY GRANT THE PETITION AND ANNEX THE ANNEXATION AREA UNLESS, NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 2, 2023, A WRITTEN PROTEST TO THE ANNEXATION PETITION (A “**PROTEST**”) IS FILED WITH THE SALT LAKE COUNTY CLERK (THE “**COUNTY CLERK**”) BY MAILING SUCH PROTEST TO THE COUNTY CLERK AT 2001 SOUTH STATE STREET, S2-200, P.O. BOX 144575, SALT LAKE CITY, UT 84114-4575. A COPY OF SUCH PROTEST MUST ALSO BE DELIVERED TO THE CITY RECORDER ON THE SAME DAY.
7. A Protest may only be filed by (a) the Salt Lake County Council; (b) the Herriman City Council; (c) the board of trustees of the (i) Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District (which is a competitor under the Petition), (ii) Unified Fire Service Area, (iii) Salt Lake Valley Law Enforcement Service Area, (iv) South Salt Lake Valley Mosquito Abatement, or (v) Utah Transit Authority; (d) an owner of rural real property¹; (e) an owner of private real property located in a mining protection area; or (f) other property owners, if such Protest contains the signatures of the owners of private real property that: (i) is located in the unincorporated area of Salt Lake County within 1/2 mile of the Annexation Area (the “**Unincorporated Area**”); (ii) covers at least 25% of the private land area located in the Unincorporated Area; and (iii) is equal in value to at least 15% of all real property located in the Unincorporated Area.
8. A Protest must state: (a) each reason for the protest of the Petition and justification for the Protest under Utah Code Annotated Title 10 Chapter 2 Part 4; (b) other information required by the County Council or any Salt Lake County ordinance, rule, or regulation; (c) additional information the party

filing the Protest considers pertinent; and (d) the name and address of a contact person who is to receive notices sent by the boundary commission to be created under Utah Code Annotated Section 10-2-409(1)(b) with respect to the Protest and all resulting proceedings.

9. The Annexation Area will be automatically withdrawn from the Unified Fire Service Area and the Salt Lake Valley Law Enforcement Service Area as provided in Utah Code Annotated Subsection 17B-1-502(2).
