

RESIDENTIAL CHICKEN REQUIREMENTS

- Allowed in single family zones (R-1.8, R-2.5, R-3, R-4, R-5) and Daybreak on properties 10,000 sq. ft. or larger.
- Maximum 6 chickens per lot. Roosters (older than 4 months) are prohibited.
- Owners are responsible for the maintenance and cleanliness of chicken facilities.
- Slaughtering/processing chickens is *not* allowed.
- Must obtain permit through the Planning Department and pay fee. Permit is *not* transferable.
- Chicken coops must meet the size and height requirements for accessory buildings in the underlying zone. A building permit is required for structures over 200 sq. ft.
