Semi Rollover Crash – Bangerter Highway

SOUTH JORDAN, UT – At 9:04 a.m. on June 14, 2019, South Jordan Police and medical units responded to a rollover crash at the intersection of 9800 S Bangerter Highway involving a passenger car and a semi-truck.

Based upon witness statements and statements from both drivers, the semi-truck was proceeding southbound on Bangerter Highway and failed to stop for a red light at 9800 South. As the semi-truck was passing through the red light, it struck an eastbound passenger car. The collision resulted in the semi-truck rolling over. The semi-truck driver (51-year-old male from Sandy, Utah) and the driver of the passenger vehicle (29-year-old male from South Jordan, Utah) were checked by paramedics on scene. Both reported minor injuries with the driver of the passenger car being transported by ambulance to a local hospital for evaluation.

The driver of the semi-truck was issued a citation for the red light violation.

“As Bangerter Highway continues to be converted to a freeway-style roadway, we are seeing the speeds increase along the highway coupled with increasing red light violations at locations where signals are still present.” Said Sgt. Samuel Winkler, South Jordan Police. “Please follow the speed limit and be prepared to stop,”
