## TERMS & CONDITIONS GOVERNING GIFT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

1. The conditions set forth on this form apply to all objects lent to the GCHC and cannot be altered, changed, waived or otherwise amended except as agreed upon in writing.

2. If the GCHC decides not to accept the item(s) and so notifies the owner, the owner has thirty days from the date of notification to reclaim the item(s), if not reclaimed at that time, the Gale Center of History and Culture shall have the right to dispose of such property in any manner it may choose.

3. The GCHC will not, and shall not be required to carry insurance against any loss, destruction, or damage to the item(s) given to the GCHC.

4. The GCHC staff does not supply appraised valuation of objects received on loan and does not accept responsibility for the adequacy and correctness of any estimates of value which may be supplied.

5. Unless the GCHC is notified in writing to the contrary, it is understood that objects given to it may be photographed by the general public, and used in all museum related publications.

6. In the event of any conflict between this Agreement and any writings, forms, or documents of the lender, the terms of this Agreement shall be controlling.

7. In receiving gifts of imported objects, the GCHC requires the donor to comply with all government customs or other requirements and will not accept responsibility for any non-compliance.

The aforesaid conditions shall apply to all objects sent to the GCHC and cannot be altered, changed, waived or otherwise affected except by written agreement of both parties. In signing this Agreement, the undersigned warrants, represents, and certifies that he or she is the legal owner or authorized agent of the legal owner of the property described on this form.
