Updated Information Regarding South Jordan Police Department's Investigation into Apparent Murder-Suicide

SOUTH JORDAN, UT – The South Jordan Police Department has confirmed the events of yesterday's tragic incident is believed to be a murder-suicide. The investigation and preliminary autopsy results indicate Seth Osborn (age 8) and Ezra Osborn (age 10) both died of gunshot wounds, which were inflicted by their father, Brian Osborn (age 41). Brian was also found deceased in the home of an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound.

On Tuesday, June 2, 2020, South Jordan Police and Fire Department responded to 4329 W. Pentenwell Ln. just after 4 P.M. on a report of an 8-year-old-male who had been found with a gunshot wound by his mother. The child was rushed to the hospital by medical personnel but tragically died of his injuries. As officers moved through the home, they found a 10-year-old-male and a 41-year-old-male both deceased of apparent gunshot wounds. Results of the investigation indicate the father was at the home watching his two sons while the mother was at work, but the father had not been living at the home for several months. South Jordan Police had previously dealt with the family on non-criminal domestic issues, but had not had contact with them since November 2019.
